

MINIMUM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The application period for admission to the BMSIM Programme follows those of other programmes offered by HSUHK, which is normally from November of the preceding year of study to August of the year of study. The minimum requirements of the Degree Programmes are as follows:

Year 1 entry

Form 6 graduates with Level 3 or above in Chinese Language and English Language, Level 2 or above in Mathematics, Liberal Studies and one other subject in HKDSE; OR

Applicants with equivalent qualifications; OR

Mature students (aged 23 or above by September of the year of admission) with a minimum of 2 years' working experience in their chosen field of study, or the ability to pursue their chosen field of study.

For students who possess qualifications other than the above, your applications will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Year 3 entry

Applicants should have completed an Associate Degree or Higher Diploma in a related discipline from a recognised institution in Hong Kong or overseas, with a minimum overall GPA of 2.5 or equivalent.

Applicants should fulfill the above minimum entry requirements and pass any assessment (e.g. written test, interview) as required by the programme. Applicants who satisfy the minimum entry requirements are not guaranteed to be admitted due to the different number of applicants, applicants' academic performance, and approved admission quotas, etc. each year.

For Non-Chinese Speaking (NCS) students in the following specific conditions:

The student has learned Chinese Language for less than six years while receiving primary and secondary education. This caters specifically to students who have a late start in the learning of Chinese Language (e.g. due to their settlement in Hong Kong well past the entry level) or who have been educated in Hong Kong sporadically; OR

The student has learned Chinese Language for six years or more in schools, but has been taught an adapted and simpler Chinese Language curriculum not normally applicable to the majority of students in our local schools.

HSUHK will accept the alternative Chinese language qualifications below as equivalent to HKDSE Chinese Language:

- Applied Learning Chinese (a minimum of "Attained")
- GCSE (a minimum of Grade C)
- IGCSE (a minimum of Grade C)
- GCE A-Level (a minimum of Grade E)
