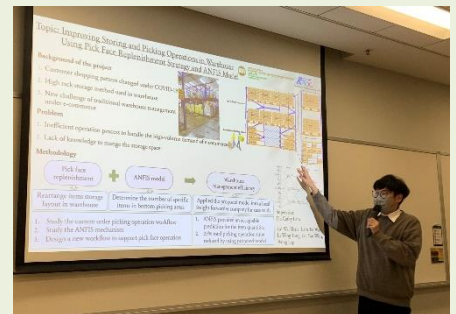
In the 2021 competition, there were two teams from the Department of Supply Chain and Information Management winning the awards of this competition. The details are shown below.

SCM Team Won the 2nd Runner-up in the CILTHK Student Day 2022 Competition 供應鏈及資訊管理學系同學於「香港運輸物流學會學界專題研習比賽2022」 榮獲季軍

The Chartered Institute of Logistics and Transport in Hong Kong (CILTHK) hosts the annual Student Day with missions to raise young people's concern about the current issues of logistics and transport in Hong Kong, and to encourage them to develop their future career in related industries. This year, the competition was held online in March amid the pandemic.

A total of seven teams formed by students from various tertiary institutions including The University of Hong Kong (HKU), The Hong Kong University of Science and Technology (HKUST), The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK) and The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU) took part in this competition. Each team was allocated a transport and logistics-related topic. Participants were required to analyse and formulate solutions for the problems under a time constraint, and present their ideas to the judging panel via zoom.

A five-member HSUHK team consisting of WOO Man Qing, WU Kwo, LI Uen Shan Chloe, CHAN Fu Wa, CHENG Yan Lok from BBA-SCM programme was coached and supervised by Dr Eugene Wong and Dr Helen Ma. With their excellent presentation and impressive analyses on the topic entitled "Assess the opportunities and challenges of autonomous driving in Hong Kong, with reference to the recent report released from a car research facility in China", the HSUHK team was awarded the 2nd runner-up. The champion and the 1st runner-up went to the HKU team and the PolyU team respectively.

The Hong Kong Logistics Case Competition 2022, organized by Hong Kong Logistics Association, was held from 3 to 5 June 2022. It aims to promote practical problem-solving skills and creative thinking capability of our post-secondary logistics students to enhance their career development. It is a team-based intensive case competition in a simulated business reality where students need to resolve workplace problems.

In the competition, each team was given a logistics management problem and was required to come up with solutions in a short period of time. A total of 10 teams from universities and community colleges in Hong Kong, took part in this hackathon competition. Our BBA-SCM student, Ho Pun Yi Charlotte teamed up with students from other institute and won the 2nd Runner-up in this competition. Congratulations to the awardees!

BBA-SCM Student Won HKIE Best Students Paper Award 2021 供應鏈管理學生榮獲「香港工程師學會最佳學生論文獎2021」

The Hong Kong Institute of Engineers - Logistics and Transportation Division (HKIE LTD) organised The HKIE LTD Best Students Papers Awards 2021 for the outstanding students who completed logistics engineering degree programs (2020/21) in Hong Kong to promote innovative ideas and research in the design and implementation of sustainable logistics and transportation systems in the territory.

The topic of this year is “Green and Smart Logistic”. The Papers submitted by the participating students were reviewed and assessed by a Judging Panel appointed by HKIE LTE Award Committee.

After several rounds of selection, including documentary assessment and video presentation, Tam Man Fei, Manviel (BBA-SCM, Year 4 student in AY2020/21) won the Best Students Papers Awards 2021 on the topic entitled “Design of Robotic Process Automation Solution for Cold Chain Management”.

The awards ceremony was held on 22 Jun 2022. Congratulations to Manviel for his outstanding work!

Three BBA (Honours) in Supply Chain Management students were awarded in the Chartered Institute of Procurement & Supply (CIPS) Best Student Awards 2021. The result announcement was made on 26 Nov 2021, Mr Lee Yu Hei, Tony received the Certificate of Merit; Ms Chan Fu Wa and Woo Man Qing received the Certificate of Credit.

This is the eighteen year that CIPS has implemented the “Best Student Award Scheme” in Hong Kong. The awards are given to full-time post-secondary students studying sub-degree or degree courses with purchasing and supply chain management as the major core competence.

Same as the previous year, the Department of Supply Chain and Information Management nominated three SCM students to the award-selection panel. Nominees were required to submit their resumes and to write an essay about “Innovative Procurement”. They were also required to attend a panel interview through which the assessment panel members discussed with them various aspects of the procurement and supply chain profession.

In March 2022, three Year-3 students from the Bachelor of Business Administration in Supply Chain Management (BBA-SCM) programme formed a team called “Track n Go” and participated in the Institute for Supply Management Hong Kong (ISM-HK) Student Case Competition 2022. The team “Track n Go” outperformed 70 teams from different universities in Hong Kong and were awarded the certificate of merit. Only top 20 percent of 88 teams with 350 student participants entered the semi-final stage. And the team “Track n Go” was one of them.

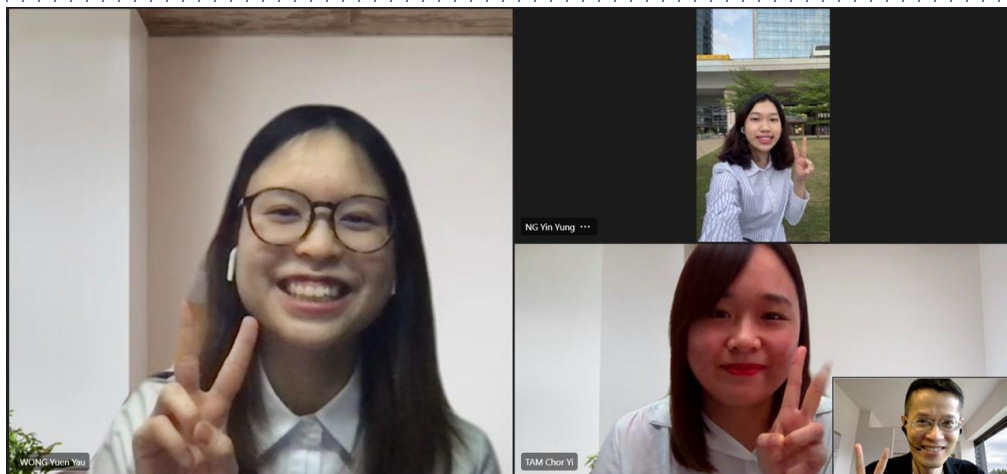

International Forum on Emerging extended reality and innovative technologies for smart transport and logistics

「智能交通和物流的新興延展實境和創新技術」- 第11屆國際航運、港口及機場論壇 (IFSPA)

An international plenary forum about “Emerging extended reality and innovative technologies for smart transport and logistics” was held on 19 May 2022. It is the closing plenary session of the 11th International Forum on Shipping, Ports and Airports (IFSPA) 2022, with over 380 participants, including professors, scholars, industry practitioners, staff and students, from over 10 countries have attended the forum.

The forum was chaired by Dr. Eugene Wong, Director of PRISC and Associate Professor of HSUHK. Six renowned speakers from the US, Singapore, Italy and Hong Kong were invited to the forum, including Dr. Michael Grives, Chief Scientist, Digital Twin Institute; Prof. Andrew Nee, Professor Emeritus of National University of Singapore; Dr. Chung Ng, Senior Vice-President, Technology Strategy and Development, HKT; Mr. Jimmy Pang, President, Supply Chain Safety and Security Association; Mr. Eric Poon, Head of Performance Enhancement, HACTL, and Dr. Graziano Terenzi, CEO, Inglobe Technologies. They have shared the latest industry development and how extended reality and innovative technologies have helped the industry to advance. Participants actively discussed and asked questions in the Q&A session. A group photo has been taken online at the end of the forum.

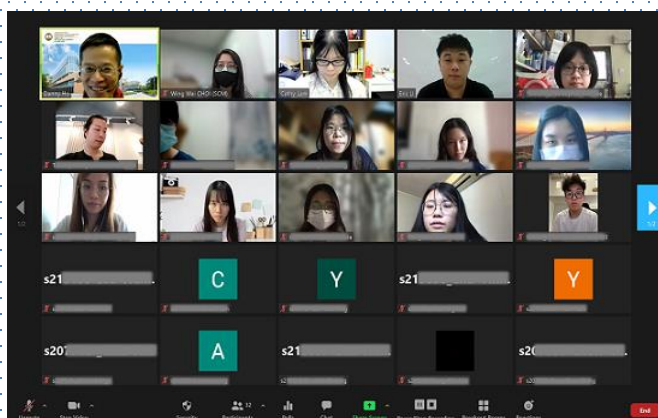

It was successfully held online on 30 May 2022 and attracted over 30 SDSC students to join.

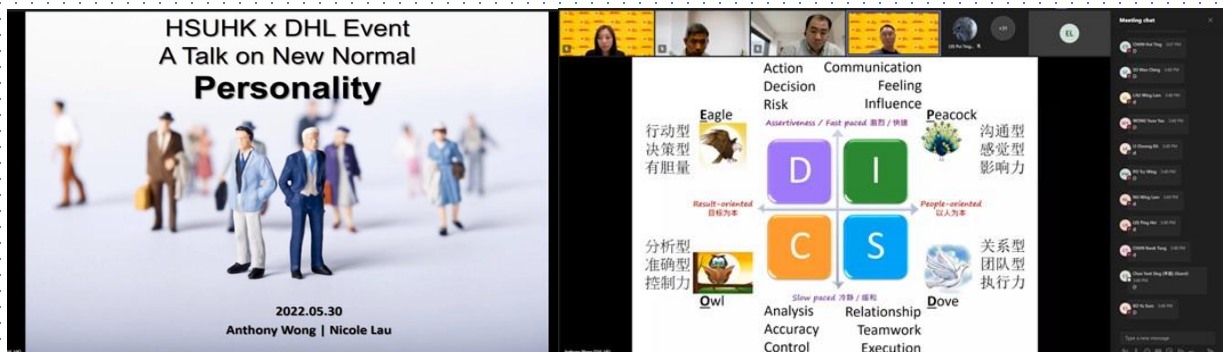
The guest speakers, Mr Anthony Wong (Vice-President of Human Resources in DHL Express Hong Kong & Macau), and Ms Nicole Lau (Senior Human Resources Manager), provided career development guidelines for our students who completed the personality test before the workshop. The workshop included interaction with interesting videos, examples and self-discovery via a personality test review for students on linking their personality traits to their career selection and development.

Through a series of demonstrations, explanations and interactions, students got well prepared for their career plan and gained better understanding of how to work with people with different personalities. In addition, the speakers provided analyses on how their personality traits manifest in their work preferences. This enhanced students' self-awareness on their strengths and weakness, such that our students would become more professional and happier in the workplace. Positive feedbacks were received from our students after the workshop.
